3. City Goals and Priorities - Continuation City Council

Deborah McMahon stated, regarding the new goals paperwork, that they have taken those goals that the Council has developed, and put them into a format to assist with budgeting. She said, regarding the Charter, that after Work Session meetings have occurred the Council would be able to review the work product. James Lewis stated the Council could invite representatives from ODOT and the County Road Department to participate in a meeting session and come up with a scope of work. Deborah McMahon said, regarding grants for zoning, staff could research what grants are available and if the timing would be right.

Mayor Woodruff suggested zoning ordinance might be a good topic for the Economic Revitalization Team (ERT) meeting to let them know that the City has this as a goal and will be looking for grants. Deborah McMahon said they talked with Andrew Spreadborough, from COIC, and asked him to keep La Pine in mind regarding any grant openings or stimulus dollars. She also said the Council could issue an RFQ that the City of La Pine is looking for qualified candidates to develop a scope and also develop a streamline plan. She said that an adopted TSP makes the State transportation entity have to acknowledge it and not ignore it.

Deborah McMahon stated that, regarding Ordinances to prevent certain activities on homeowner's property, she strongly advised the City to involve the Chamber of Commerce and neighborhoods in that process. She also suggested that action dealing with wildfire and safety issues should be at the top of the list. Councilor Shields suggested putting other ordinances like code enforcement under long term goals. The Council concurred with this decision.
