- Any facts received, noticed or recognized outside of the hearing will be stated for the record.
- Challenges to the Council’s qualifications to hear the matter shall be stated and challenges entertained. Then, Council will proceed as follows:
 - a. Open the hearing.
 - b. Staff report. – Will Groves, Deschutes County - Deborah McMahon, City
 - c. Proponents' presentation, including any request for leaving the record open or continuance.
 - d. Opponents' presentation, including any request for leaving the record open or continuance.
 - e. Proponents' rebuttal.
 - f. Opponents' rebuttal may be allowed at the Council’s discretion.
 - g. Staff comments, if necessary.
 - h. Questions from or to the Council may be entertained at any time at the Council’s discretion.
 - i. Recognize requests for continuance/leaving the record open for written comment.
 - j. Close the hearing.
