

ORDINANCE NO. 2009-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE DEFINITION OF "CHIEF PROCUREMENT OFFICER" AS DEFINED IN ORDINANCE NO. 2008-01, WHICH ORDINANCE ADOPTED RULES AND PROCEDURE RELATING TO PUBLIC CONTRACTING AND WAS PASSED AND APPROVED JUNE 25, 2008.

WHEREAS, the City of La Pine, an Oregon municipal corporation ("City"), adopted the Public Contracting Ordinance, Ordinance No. 2008-01, to establish certain rules and procedure relating to public contracting;


WHEREAS, the City desires to amend the definition of "Chief Procurement Officer" as defined in the Public Contracting Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of La Pine ordains as follows:


Section B(2) of Exhibit A to the Public Contracting Ordinance, City's Public Contracting Rules, is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"Unless expressly limited by the LCRB or these Rules, all powers and duties given or assigned to contracting agencies by the Public Contracting Code may be exercised or performed by the Mayor, as "Chief Procurement Officer," or the Mayor's designee, including the authority to enter into emergency contracts pursuant to ORS 279B.080. Notwithstanding the foregoing, all contracts in excess of \$5,000 shall be approved by the LCRB."

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, this Ordinance was PASSED by the La Pine City Council by a vote of 4 for and 0 against and APPROVED by the Mayor on this 11th day of MARCH, 2009. This Ordinance will be effective April 10, 2009.
