

**ORDINANCE NO. 2010-01**

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2007-4, AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING LICENSES FOR TRADES, SHOPS, OCCUPATIONS, PROFESSIONS, AND CERTAIN OTHER BUSINESSES FOR THE PURPOSE OF REVENUE AND REGULATION.**

WHEREAS, on November 14, 2007, the City of La Pine, an Oregon municipal Corporation (the "City"), adopted Ordinance No. 2007-4, an ordinance requiring licenses for trades, shops, occupations, professions, and certain other businesses for the purpose of revenue and regulation; providing for the method of issuing licenses; providing penalties for violations (the "Business License Ordinance");

WHEREAS, the La Pine City Council (the "City Council") has determined that under the present circumstances the City is incapable of properly implementing the Business License Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to repeal the Business License Ordinance in its entirety by its approval and adoption of this Ordinance No. 2010-01.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF LA PINE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:
